

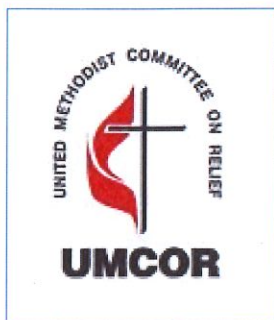

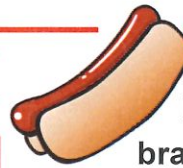


Hurricane Dorian and other natural disasters are devastating to the lives of God's children. You are invited to consider making a donation at

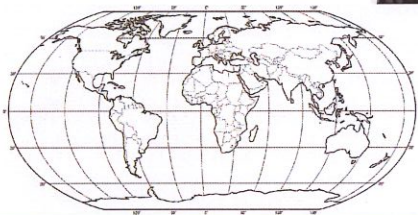
